We will be sending a reminder to those of you who have one of our lovely R+S Banners, (there are only 10) as we would like to get them up earlier this year. We plan to do a Press Launch of Ride+Stride in July, it was in Shrewsbury in 2015 and we hope to be in Oswestry this year, and it would be great if the Banners can go up to co-incide with that date,date to be confirmed!

Finally a plea from us!

Last year we had 209 churches and chapels open on the day, but only 83 actually participated....i.e. made any money!

Having your church or chapel open is great, but if no one participates neither the SHCT nor your church receive any money, and R+S needs to continue to raise money to help fund the grants we award each year.

In 2015 SHCT gave out £49,965 between 10 churches, and already this year another 4 churches have been promised a grant, with 4 pending and the year is still young!

Please do contact us if we can be of further help, and remember there are other ways to participate in Ride+Stride beside the obvious!

- 1. Fill a car with friends and drive to an area where you can easily walk between a few churches and chapels, e.g. Oswestry, Ludlow, Telford, and Shrewsbury.
- 2. Invite friends to visit a church or chapel near you, give them a Tour with a little history and invite them back to afternoon tea at your home, and charge them at least £5 each! It is much easier than getting sponsorship.
- 3. Use Park & Ride, and go into town on the bus, e.g. you can walk between at least 13 churches open in Shrewsbury.
