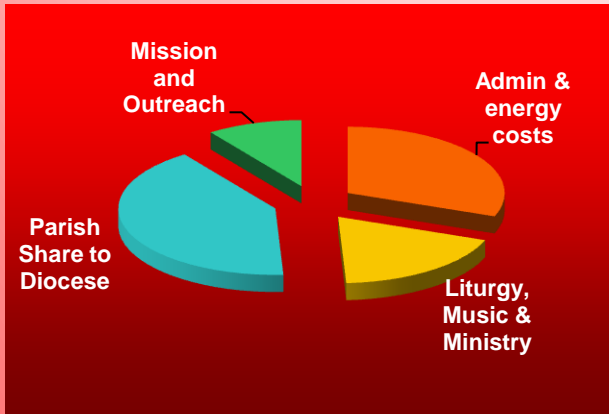
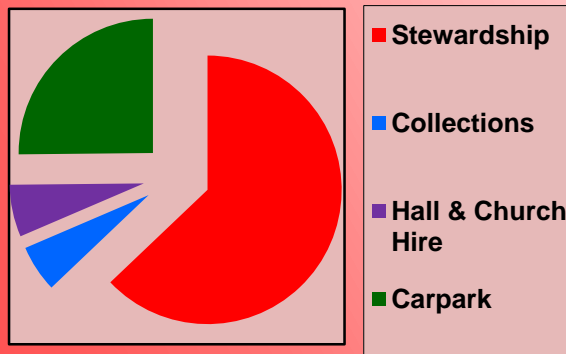


What do we need?



In 2012 projected total expenditure = £330,000.

Where does it come from?



The Church of England Synod recommends giving 5% of your income for stewardship.

It costs nearly £1,000 per day for the running of St Chad's.

St Chad's receives no money directly from the Government or Diocese for running costs.

Stewardship giving at St Chad's is 20% below the national average.

For many years, reserves have been used to subsidise income, leaving reserves at a critical level.

On average we need an extra 25% on stewardship pledges to meet our daily running costs.

More than ever, St Chad's relies on the generosity of people who love and value it.

What can you do?

- Review your giving

Can you increase your giving by 25% or more? Most people at St Chad's have not increased their giving for at least 3 years!

- Join Our Stewardship Scheme

Making a regular standing order from your bank to the church on a monthly basis or by using weekly envelopes.

- Complete the Gift Aid Form

If you are a UK tax payer, HMRC will refund to the church an extra 25% of the sum you have paid.

St Chad's is kept standing by a regular monthly income from congregation & friends.
